This was the first meeting of the entire Storm Water Management Team. Wendel has been working with Eric Ungs to put together sample policies to address the requirements of the University's NPDES permit. Eric has developed sample policy statements that address illicit discharge prohibition, post-construction site runoff control, and construction site runoff control. Copies were distributed to the members for review and comment.

There was discussion about the manner in which storm water management information could be distributed to the campus community and it appears that articles about storm water management could be placed on the facilities services web site and links identified to related web sites.

Dean will talk to Dave Zarifis about using the public safety business number as the 24-hour storm water hotline for the university community and the public to use to report concerns.

Wendel Reece is working with Dave Andersen to identify storm water intake and outfall locations. The intent is to integrate with GIS when possible. Dean will meet with Ron Arends, Cedar Falls senior engineer on February 22<sup>nd</sup> to discuss the City's storm drain stenciling program with the intent to replicate the process for the campus.

The Team decided to meet quarterly with the next meeting to be scheduled in April 2007.
